WIC helps pregnant women, new mothers and young children eat well and stay healthy.

- Pregnant, breastfeeding or just had a baby
- Infants and Children under 5 years old (incl. foster children)
- Families with medium to low income

W.I.C. can provide:

- A WIC EBT card to buy healthy foods – like milk, juice, eggs, cheese, cereal, fruits, vegetables, and peanut butter
- Information about nutrition and health to help you and your family eat well and healthy
- Information and support for breastfeeding
- Help in finding health care and other services in the area

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

PREPARING FOR, RESPONDING TO, AND RECOVERING FROM EMERGENCIES AND DISASTERS OF ALL KINDS.

During and following a disaster, public health professionals, first responders, and community officials work together to minimize death and injuries, prevent disease outbreaks and illnesses.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

Food Protection: Permits and inspects food establishments operating in Effingham County. Our goal is to reduce the occurrence of foodborne illness and to promote safe food practices.

Private Sewage Disposal: Issues construction permits for new or renovated private sewage disposal systems, conducts inspections, and conducts complaint investigations.

Private Water: Issues construction permits for water wells and closed loop (geothermal) wells, regulates non-community public water supplies.

Vector Surveillance & Control: Conducts surveillance activities to identify, control, and reduce the population of specific insects that have the potential for becoming disease vectors.

Tobacco Prevention: Conducts compliance inspections for the Smoke Free Illinois Act, provides tobacco / vaping prevention curriculum to youth, and promotes the Illinois Tobacco Quitline.
